## Vision of R10 PAC Challenge

R10 Professional Activities Committee (PAC) invites proposals around any new initiative that is aimed towards maintaining and enhancing IEEE members' lifelong professional career prospects and growth

#### IEEE R10 PAC Objectives

- Maintain and enhance members' lifelong employability and career prospects
- Enhance the R10 PA process and leadership for professional activities
- Supporting R10 versions of SmartTech/ HardTech events and conduct IEEE Future directions workshop/hackathon etc.
- Conducting events for members interested in Government and Technical Policy activities, informed by IEEE expertise

#### R10 PAC Challenge Funding Criteria

The R10 PAC Challenge proposals submission request can be of two pathways:

- Matching section funding for those applications that have PACE\* Coordinator
- Stand-alone requests for sections without PACE\* structures, primarily aimed at helping establish one operational by 2020

## R10 PAC Challenge Dates

- Deadline of Submission: 6<sup>th</sup> May 2019
- Notification of Acceptance: 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019
- Bonus: Reporting within 3 week of activity
- \*PACE <u>P</u>rofessional <u>A</u>ctivities <u>C</u>ommittees for <u>E</u>ngineers (Generally Sections have coordinators for this role)

#### 2019 R10 PAC Challenge Goals

- To support a new initiative or event under the umbrella of existing PACE\* activities within a IEEE R10 section or help establish PACE\* structures
- To identify project or idea, that IEEE section can conduct regularly, to benefit particularly longstanding members' professional aspiration
- Events are not limited to be specific but shall be more focused on set of particular professional initiatives that is typical in IEEE USA & R1-R7
- R10 PAC Challenge is looking to support executable idea that strongly aligns with PAC objectives

## 2019 R10 PAC Funding Overview

- R10 PAC committee has funds to support about 5 PAC challenges and few SmartTech/HardTech or IEEE Future Directions events in 2019
- Maximum support of US\$500, if stand-alone, and negotiable if matching funds are in the budget
- Completed projects can also earn US\$100, as completion bonus by submitting an activity poster to R10 PAC, to be used as best-practice exemplars

### 2019 R10 PAC Proposal Submission

- All submitted proposals has to be endorsed by Section Chair of the host R10 Section/Council
- Section Chairs can forward multiple initiatives, but only one will receive R10 PAC Challenge support.
- Proposals can be submitted, using Xcel template provided, through to ieeer10pac@ieee.org
